

“Fruit of the Loom’s response”, 30 September 2025

Thank you for your email outlining concerns regarding potential business ties to Fatullah Fabrics and Bay Creation in Bangladesh. Neither Fruit of the Loom nor any of our operating companies have a direct relationship with either of the factories you listed. Our investigation revealed the following:

Fatullah Fabrics

One of our licensees for the Spalding brand, United Sports Brands, sources from Fatullah Apparel, but according to their contacts at Fatullah Apparel, there is no association with any company called Fatullah Fabrics and their Spalding production. So at this point, we cannot establish an association/connection between Fatullah Fabrics and any of our brands. If you can provide additional information on the connection between that company and our brand, we will be glad to inquire further.

Bay Creation

One of our licensees for the Russell brand, J Brands International, previously sourced from Bay Creation. The last order from that facility shipped in December 2024, with production occurring between April 2024 and December 2024. Bay Creation was deactivated from J Brands International’s supply chain in June of this year following six months of inactivity.
